Railway

Only a short Distance from development is Anniesland Train Station and Hillhead underground, taking you into Glasgow City Centre and surrounding areas.

Bus

There are a number of Bus Routes departing from the area including Buses 11, 16, 66, 20, 220 which alight in the City Centre and West End area of Glasgow.

Local Amenities

Supermarkets in the areas are not hard to find with a local Waitrose, Tesco and Morrison's supermarkets all within a 1 miles radius from the development.

Pubs/Restaurants/Nightlife

Schools

Local High schools include Glasgow High, Kelvinside Academy and Notre Dame High School. Anniesland College is also only a short distance away.
